## **St. Julian's Primary School – Admissions Policy**

---

The Admissions Policy operates in-line with Newport City Council's Policy for Admissions to Nursery and Primary Schools. Therefore, this policy statement should be read in conjunction with that policy, which is to be found on the Newport City Council's website.

Under the Council's Policy, parents apply to Newport City Council, which allocates a school place. The school is not able to admit pupils.

The Council has agreed criteria by which it allocates places, and this is to be found in its Policy. All schools have a Pupil Admission Number, based on the capacity of the school. At St. Julian's, that number is 90 in each year group. Foundation Phase classes have a statutory maximum size of 30. A maximum of 30 in Key Stage 2 classes is a guide.

Parents should refer to the Council Policy to find the timetable for applications to Nursery, Reception and Secondary School. Pupils in Nursery do not automatically have a place in Reception and Year 6 pupils do not automatically have a place at the local comprehensive school. It is necessary to apply for those places, and the school would advise parents to apply as soon as the window for applications opens in order to secure a place.
