### **Pupil Internet Code of Conduct**

Internet access will be allowed when this form has been read, signed and returned to school.

At St. Julian's Primary School we expect all pupils to be responsible for their own behaviour on the internet, just as they are anywhere else in school. This includes materials they choose to access and language they use.

Pupils must not seek out offensive materials. Should any pupil encounter any such material they are expected to turn the screen off and report it immediately to a teacher. The system used by the school is overseen by Newport City Council's SRS team. Strict controls are in place but no internet system is completely safe.

Pupils must not use offensive language in their e-mail communications and should only contact people that the teacher has approved.

Pupils must not use the internet without permission from a teacher.		
Pupils must not access anyone else's files.		
Any child abusing these arrangements will be	denied access to internet resources.
